MESSAGE FROM OUR BISHOP

To: The Holy Convocation of the RZUA Churches of America

Greetings in the Name of Him who loved us enough to lay down His life for us, It is with excitement and new hope that we refocus the Holy Convocation this year. In 2016, we followed the original outline presented by those who formed our holy convocations over twenty years ago. This year, we seek to present it from a different perspective. The convocation committee has always put a lot of effort into planning it and this year is no different. Many have worked in the planning and many changes have been, and are being made as we go along. I extend my sincere gratitude to all of them for that.



The focus this year is on "holiness." In 1 Peter 1:16 (NIV), the Bible says: 'for it is written: "Be holy, because I am holy."' As we focus on being Christian, it is also important that we focus on being like Christ: Holy. This design will present a holy convocation according to the original intent and plan for holy convocations that God required of Israel.

When we think of "Holy Convocation," we think of a sacred assembly set apart for the purpose of worshiping God and bringing our offerings to Him. Here, offerings do not mean goats, sheep, and bulls; it is our coming before Him in an attitude of holiness. Our holiness is based both on the position, granted because God loved us and chose us in Christ to be holy and without fault in His eyes, and the behavior that results from holding this position. While our Holy Convocation is not developed in the exact blueprint of the Jewish Assembly, it will reflect a Christian adaptation of that model.

Again, I invite you to focus on holiness for this convocation and enjoy the journey

ABOUT HOLY CONVOCATION

By Bishop John L. Ghee

Exodus 12:16 (KJV): "And in the first day there shall be an holy convocation, and in the seventh day there shall be an holy convocation to you; no manner of work shall be done in them, save that which every man must eat, that only may be done to you."

Deuteronomy 31:12 (KJV): "Gather the people together, men and women, and children, and thy stranger that is within thy gates that they may hear, and that they may learn, and fear the Lord your God, and observe to do all the words of this law."

These texts are calls to worship. They call for not just "a coming together of the church body to take care of business," but a coming together to "bring God glory through worship, praise, and reverence!" Looking past the timing to the event, the call is to "hold a sacred assembly"—an approach to worship with pure, godly intentions and a willingness to hear from and respond to the heart of God. Thus, holy convocation is the epitome of walking in right relationship with God. It anticipates confession and repentance in preparation for worship. Therefore, restoration becomes reality during the event. Confession and repentance, the casting off of those weights that beset us (Heb. 12:1), is like consuming the bread that has no leavening and living a life from which sin has been excluded. This is God's desire for us.

Further, the call is to begin the event ("on the first day...") with a sacred assembly. We are reminded as we begin our preparation for presenting ourselves before the Lord, the intent must already be to demonstrate "holiness to the Lord." It is impossible to walk out of sin into holiness as crossing a line drawn in the sand without some preparation (confession and repentance). That would be tantamount to entering into heaven in the body of flesh. During the gathering together in the event of the Exodus era, true worship and fellowship were to be experienced through praise, prayer, dance, reading of the law, singing of psalms, and making music on the instruments. Then at the end of the assembly, the seventh day, there was another sacred assembly. The two occurrences in one event of the "high holy" assembly, were, above all else, pleasing to God.

I believe our every effort should be representative of our attitude of holiness to the Lord. So then, looking back, I realize we do not traditionally use the unleavened bread, except at our Holy Communion services. Since we are meeting in this worship for just two days, we will intentionally prepare for and make these two days, the first day and the last day, Holy to the Lord, not just in word, but in preparation, plan, and action. Our work will conform to the requirement of the Lord. Even in the sacred assembly, God requires our obedience. The result of obedience to God is blessings. Let us, together, obey Him. He has always kept His promise to us. Let us, now, keep our promise to Him. To God be the glory forever!


